




A quick reference book for close reading strategies





- □ Give a purpose for each reading. When students have a purpose for reading, it will not seem repetitive.
- Make the length of the text manageable. Text that is too long can seem overwhelming for students but text that is too short will not allow for deep thinking.
- Also make the length of the response pages manageable. Students should be able to complete the reading and response in one given time period.
- □ Have tools accessible to use for close reading. Have students use annotating bookmarks or sticky notes. Providing tools will make close reading interesting while keeping the purpose within their focus.
- ☐ Model how close reading is different than simply re-reading the text.
- ☐ Give students the opportunity to discuss the text and the reading












Take the stress out of close reading practice with everything you need!
